## 1A APPLICATION FOR CONSIDERATION

#### The Ridge SCIO

The Common Good Committee considered an application by The Ridge SCIO for the repair of the Garden Lane 'Bird Gate' which was damaged over the period of construction works within Black Bull Close/Backlands and phase 2 of the mosaic project in Empire Close.

This application had previously been presented to the Committee on 3 October 2024, at which time they approved funding of  $\pounds$ 5,000. However, following that meeting, it came to light that the Committee only had  $\pounds$ 4,000 in their grants budget for 2023/24, hence the need for the Committee to reconvene to reconsider the application.

#### Decision

The Common Good Committee agreed to grant the application in part: the sum of  $\pounds 4,000$ , as after reviewing the cost of the project Members felt it could be delivered for less than the amount asked for in the application.
